Requirements for reopening

Up to 20 patrons within a single space, subject to four square metre rule



Single groups of up to 10 patrons can dine or drink together

Alcohol can be served without a meal when seated



Space tables so that patrons are seated 1.5 metres away from patrons at neighbouring tables



TAB and KENO* facilities inside licenced venues can open (*gamble responsibly)

Restaurants, bars, cafes, pubs and nightclubs are open for table service

Keeping your workplace safe

- Stay home if you or someone in your household are unwell
- If you have **symptoms** of coronavirus (COVID-19), even if they are mild, you should **get tested**
- Space tables so that patrons are 1.5 metres apart from a neighbouring table when seated
- Provide hand sanitiser in clearly accessible locations
- Regularly and thoroughly clean and disinfect your venue
- Record contact details for all patrons who visit for longer than 15 minutes for rapid contact tracing
- At least one staff member should complete the **Victorian Government online Coronavirus** (COVID-19) training
- ✓ Have response plans in place in case of a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19)
- Staff have the right to refuse entry or ask patrons to leave if they breach restrictions
- Provide staff the Hospitality Industry Guidelines
- Encourage staff to complete the **Staff Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Questionnaire** before each shift
